ORDER

For the reasons stated more fully at the hearing this date, plaintiff’s Motion to Compel 30(b)(6) Deposition [Doc. #332] is **GRANTED IN PART** and **DENIED IN PART**. The motion is denied insofar as it seeks to compel the deposition of a 30(b)(6) witness, in light of the depositions of City personnel already conducted and the narrow category of information plaintiff indicates she still needs. Plaintiff will, however, be allowed to propound supplemental interrogatories to defendant limited to the topic of training of department personnel in handling sexual misconduct allegations. The interrogatories shall be served by August 9, 2021, and shall avoid repetition of matters substantially addressed by prior City witnesses binding the City to the information provided. The city’s responses shall be responsive to the additional information sought, so as to avoid unnecessary further argument as to the responses.
