We are investigating a fatal pedestrian hit and run accident that occurred in Manitowoc County in January 1999. A 17-year old male was walking along the side of the roadway late at night and was struck from behind by the suspect vehicle.

There was very little evidence left at the scene except for some plastic grill pieces from the offending vehicle. We believe these pieces may have come from a 1985 - 1991 Chevrolet van or pick-up.

We need to know the true make, model, color and type of vehicle involved in this case. This information would greatly assist in narrowing the scope of our investigation.
