

Attorneys broker deal to dismiss two jurors

Woman who had served in detective's case is one of choices

Kratz and Dean Strang, one of Steven Avery's defense lawyers, requested the deal that let them pick which jurors would be excluded from the deliberations.

There are no criteria for pre-judicial strikes, meaning lawyers need not explain their reasons for sending a juror packing.

One of the rejected jurors was the one who Strang had been lobbying to dismiss since it was learned that she was a member of the jury.

At the conclusion of the arguments today, one juror will be selected as an alternate and remain sequestered while the jury deliberates and remain sequestered until the verdict is reached.

The alternate could get called into service if something happens to one of the 12 seated jurors during deliberations.
